**Saturday, June 14**

- 2pm Pack gathers at Camp Coombs in uniform. As we need to unlock the gate it is easier if we all arrive about the same time; we'll leave the gate open till 5pm then phone my cell if you need it opened after that. Set up camp.
- 2:30pm Flag ceremony (in uniform)
- 2:45pm Scout Skills - setting up, and taking down a tent
- 3:15pm Games - soccer or baseball
- 4pm Scout Skills - knot tying
- 4:30pm Cooking - we need to involve the cubs in preparation/cooking as much as possible which means foil cooking etc.
- 5:15pm Eating
- 5:45pm Clean up - again involve cubs as much as possible.
- 6:15pm Games - kickball
- 7:15pm Scout Skills - fires and fire safety
- 7:30pm Flag ceremony (in uniform)
- 7:45pm Campfire (dusk is 8pm or so). The den chiefs will help build, light, supervise the campfire. We will have s'mores, etc.
- 9pm Bed

**Sunday, June 15**

- 7am Wakeup
- 7:45am Flag ceremony and prayers (in uniform)
- 8am Breakfast - pancakes, bacon, fruit etc.
