Cub Master's Report:

1. Since 9/1/09; 12 Cub Scouts registered, at least 6 more attending and waiting for registration forms. There's 55 Cub Scouts registered in Pack 118, to date. This is a 15 person increase over last year (40 Cub Scouts were registered).
